URSULA VON RYDINGSVARD

Based in the U.S. since 1950, the German-born Polish artist is known for imposing, rough-hewn wooden forms inspired by the shapes of much smaller items such as bowls, scrubbing implements and veils. "Ursula von Rydingsvard: Sculpture, 1991-2010" reveals her formal debt to rural Polish craftsmen as well as Giacometti and other artists. The exhibition debuts at the Sculpture Center, New York, Jan. 23-Mar. 28, 2011,

and travels to the DeCordova Museum and Sculpture Park, Lincoln, Mass., May 16-Aug. 28, 2011, and the Frost Art Museum, Miami, Jan. 15-Mar. 15, 2012.
